

An Industrial Visit to Mysore

An Industrial visit to Mysore was organized by the Post Graduate Department of Commerce and Management, Seshadripuram First Grade College, Yelahanka on April 3rd 2019. The three Industries which were covered in the visit were Mysore Milk Union Limited, Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation Limited, Karnataka Soaps and Detergents Limited. Providing students an exposure about Practical working environment was the aim of the Industrial visit. Prof. Aafaq Ahmed and Dr. Shantashri H had accompanied students in the Industrial Visit.

All the students had assembled at around 6.15AM in the college campus and departure to Mysore was at 6.30AM. Breakfast was arranged in a Park in Ramanagara at 8.30AM. After having breakfast again the journey to Mysore was continued. The destination was reached at 11.30AM. The first industry which we visited was Mysore Milk Union Limited at 12.15PM. The Guide helped all the students in knowing how the milk is collected from different places, how the quality of milk is checked and how is it processed, how the packaging is done and the Guide also showed all the students, the different products that are manufactured in the Industry like sweets, butter, ghee, etc. By 1.30PM, the visit to Mysore Milk Union Limited was complete.

At around 1.45PM, we reached the Regional Museum of National History. The museum exhibited plants, animals and geology of the southern region of India. It emphasizes on the conservation of nature and natural resources. At 2.15PM, Lunch was arranged in the campus of the museum. After having lunch, at 2.45PM we left to Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation Limited.

At around 3.10PM, we entered the Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation Limited. The employees explained the students how the silk threads are extracted, the process of weaving, the process of dyeing and gave us idea on the price range of the products which are manufactured there. At around 3.45PM, the visit to Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation was complete.

After visiting Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation, at around 4PM we reached the campus of Karnataka Soaps and Detergents Limited. It is a company owned by the Government of India. It is into manufacturing of soaps and detergents. The Employee of the Karnataka Soaps and Detergents Limited divided the students into two batches to visit the industry. He explained about the features of Sandalwood tree, the process by which oil is extracted from the wood and also explained the process by which soap is manufactured. Also, showed us the outlet where the products of Karnataka Soaps and Detergents Limited were sold, which was present in the campus. Both batches completed the visit at around 5.30PM.

At 5.30PM, snacks was arranged in the Karnataka Soaps and Detergents Limited's campus. Later, all the students and faculty members left to Ranganathaswamy Temple, Srirangapatna. All the students and faculty members visited the temple and departure to Bangalore was at 6.45PM. We reached Bangalore at around 10.45PM.

On the whole, the industrial visit was very fruitful as all the students got exposure to practical learning that is how theatrical concepts are put into action, it helped the students to improve interpersonal and communication skills.
