

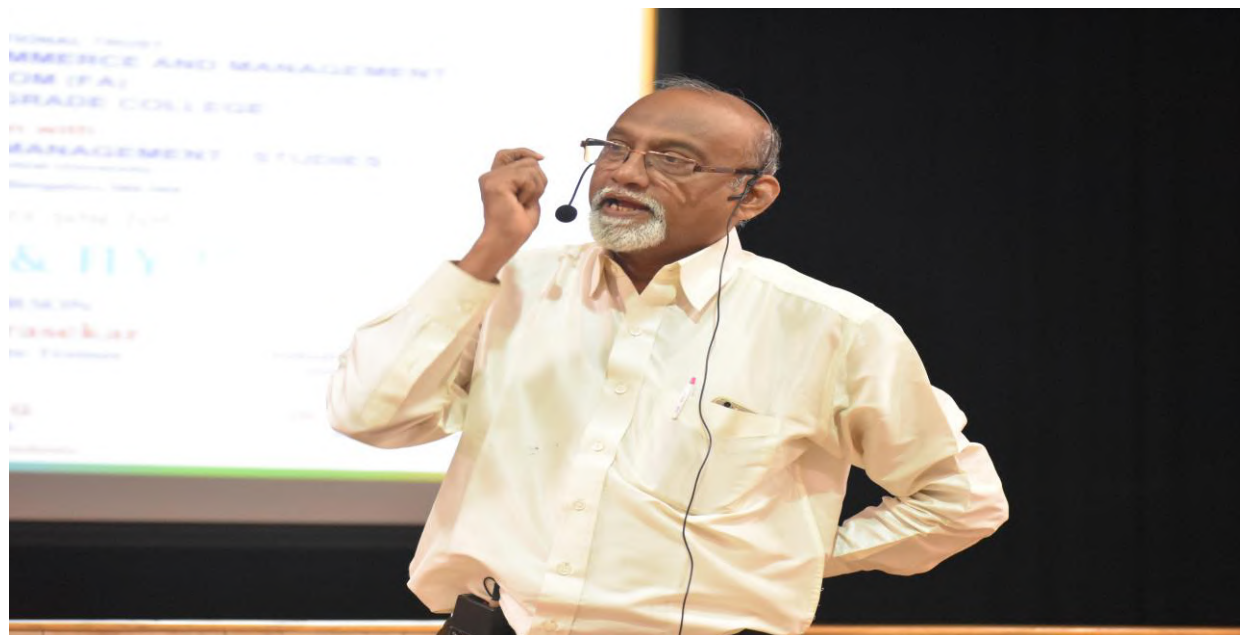

On 29<sup>th</sup> November 2018, “Run, Jump & Fly?” Workshop was organized by the PG Department of Commerce and Management, Seshadripuram First Grade College, Yelahanka from 9.30AM to 4.30PM in the Auditorium, SFGC, Yelahanka.
